COURSE NAME: Company Officer 401

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This course assists student-learners in analyzing, planning and strategizing for effective responses to emergency incidents; and provides the student-learner with knowledge to identify safety concerns that affect emergency responder safety at emergency situations; and provides fire department personnel with a general understanding of building construction types and how each performs under exposure to fire. The objective is to expose company officers to processes, activities and data involved in pre-incident planning, responsibilities of an incident safety officer, and building construction consideration for fire department operations.
